- Clinical guidelines and pathways

- Peer-to-peer consultations with MD Anderson faculty
- Expanded educational opportunities
- Measurement, benchmarking & continuous quality improvement
- Safety monitoring

Second Opinion Clinic

- Purely **Consultative**
- Leverages the MD Anderson affiliation to benefit the **community**
 - No need to travel “**down the road**” for a second opinion at an AMC
- FRHS physicians provide independent consultation with patient
- Followed by MD Anderson Faculty peer to peer evaluation
- Follow up with patient after peer to peer
- Communication with patient and primary care provider
 - If recommendations concordant with first opinion, patient advised to remain with that physician
 - If recommendations discordant, rationale communicated to patient and PCP
 - Ultimate decision resides with patient and PCP
